Nov.2011 – Oct.2012: EIFL/PLIP grant project «**Youth IT-Yurt**» for unemployed youth. The goal is to provide access to ICT, e-education and continue education in order to improve their life. **244 unemployed people** and those who were under the dismissal participated took part in **74 trainings and seminars** (31 trainings of them – in the Kazak). **It is 483 lessons.** **Zhaniya Shukyurova**, Elevator stockman: "I didn't have a choice. I am to learn Excel and Accountancy program or I'll be fired. In the evening I ran to the library after the work in order to visit the workshop. I have got what I wanted and I didn't lose my job in a month."
